Language: English

Cost: Journey to and from the camp, as well as insurance to be paid by the participant. Plus € 300 for the camp, pay on arrival and some pocket money.

Clothing: Warm clothes for wind and rain, swimming suit and good shoes for hiking in the mountain and walking on Ice. (No special equipment is needed.)

Food: Traditional Icelandic food and international food. Please inform us if you have any restrictions in type of food.

Insurance: Participants must be insured against illness, accidents and third party liabilities according to Rotary International recommendations.

Internet information: The camp can be followed on the internet, with regular updates. A great way for the folks at home to enjoy the camp too.
