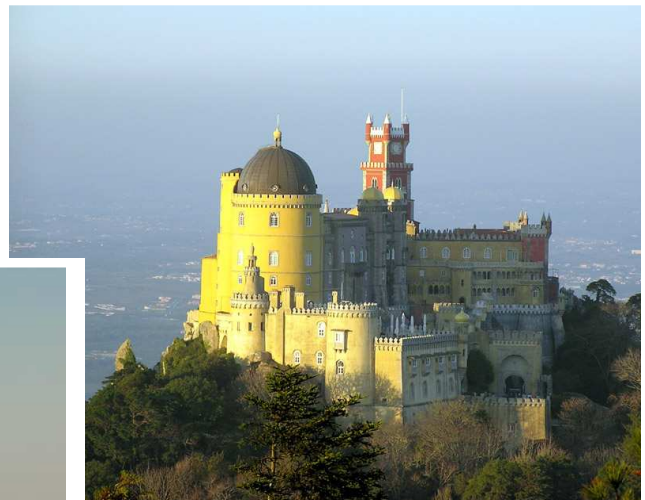
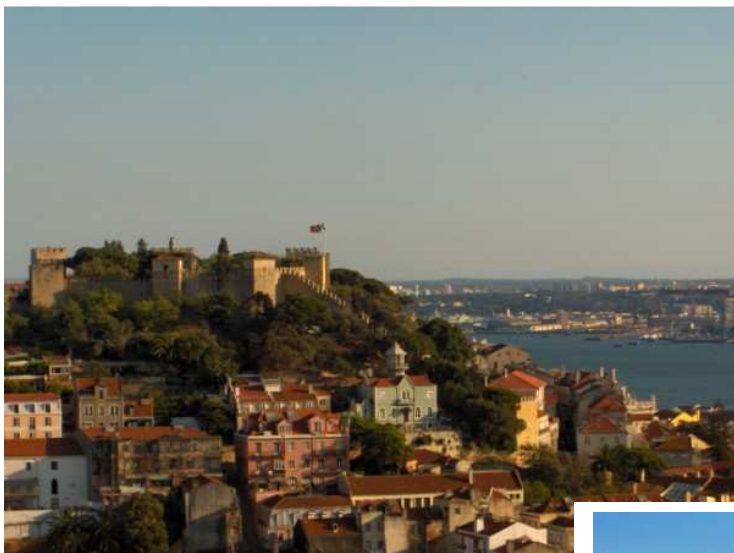

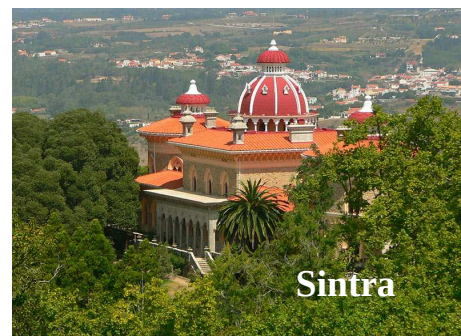
Participants Art skills (drawing, painting, photography, filming, ...) will be welcomed to document activities and visits.

Bring your smiles with you. Our arms are already open to embrace you !



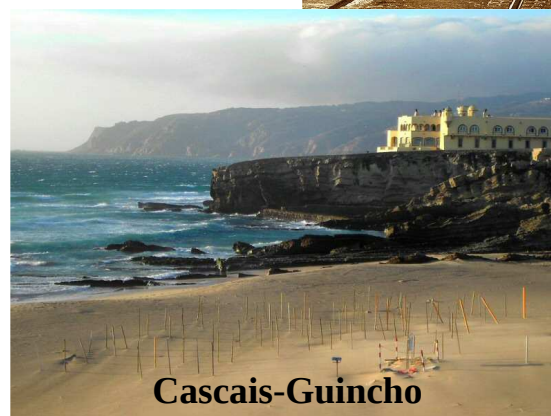
