[SAT] 16 JULY - 24 JULY [SUN]

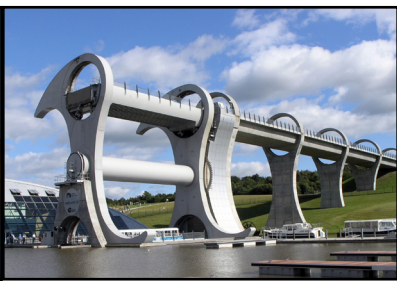
This camp is open to a maximum of twelve girls and boys, aged 17 to 18 years. This is not a tourist holiday but is specifically designed to enable participants to experience our culture and way of life. An exciting and interesting programme is offered including visits to the theatre, the world famous Edinburgh Castle, a boat trip to the Falkirk Wheel, art galleries as well as the Edinburgh Rotary Club. As the programme includes some walks, you should come with appropriate clothing for all events. The common language is English and the food is mainly European. Our guests will be home hosted with Rotarian families. Full details will be supplied to accepted participants.

All travel from home to and from Edinburgh airport will be met by the participants. There will be a charge of **£350** for all activities, payable in advance after your registration has been accepted.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

- 1) We receive information about country, age and gender of candidate.
- 2) We must receive completed Rotary application forms from candidates and their sponsoring club within two weeks of acceptance of registration which will confirm the offer of a place on the Youth Camp (subject to point 4 below). If not, registration is automatically cancelled.
- 3) The fee of £350 has to be paid into our bank account (details to be advised) no later than four weeks after we have accepted your registration. Failure to do so will result in your registration being cancelled and the next reserve candidate informed.
- 4) Confirmation of your placement will be sent when we have received your fee.
- 5) In the case of accepted students withdrawing up to 20th April 2016, the fee will be refunded in full. After this date there will be no refund. We therefore recommend that the participants get special cancellation insurance.
- 6) All participants must be insured against illness, accident and third party damages according to Rotary International recommendations.
- 7) Visa : All applicants will be expected to make their own visa arrangements.
- 8) Full details of programme, where you will be staying, what to bring, etc will be sent to each successful student in advance of the Youth Camp.
