Overnight on the boat. Night sail to Barcelona.

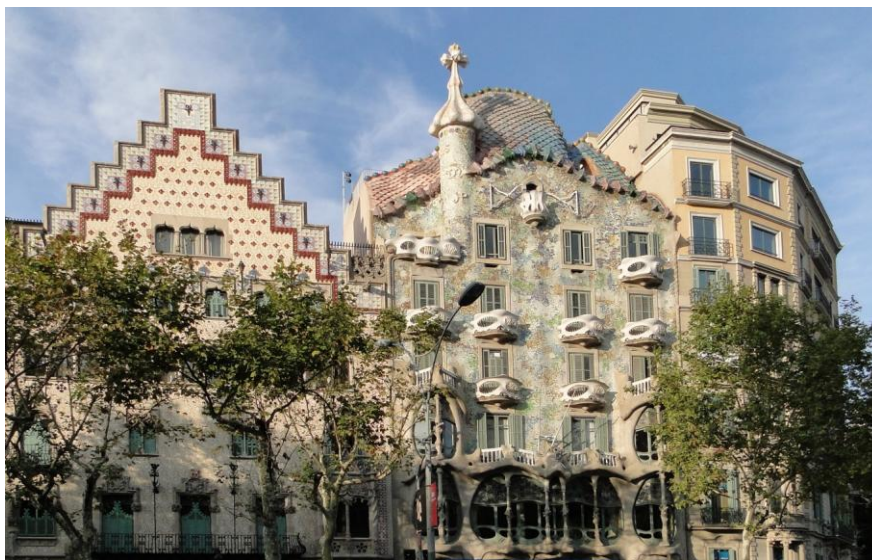


Friday, July 10: Arrival at Barcelona Olímpic Marina, where the young people will be picked up by Rotarian families.
