Bremen is about 60 km (37 miles) south from the Weser mouth on the North Sea. With Bremerhaven right on the mouth Bremen comprises the state of the Free Hanseatic City of Bremen.

The 8 Rotary Clubs in Bremen and the E-Club of 1850 have prepared a varied programme for you.

The Summer Camp 2016 is for 18 young people between 18 and 25 from all over Europe. Besides there are no restrictions where you come from.
