Aim of Camp: Sailing on Como Lake and Introduction to Northern Italy

Where: The sailing school is in Dervio, Como Lake. There will be also a program, during the second week, including visit to Bellagio (pearl of our Lake), Go-Kart race, culture and shopping in Milan, running on Monza International racing circuit with Ferrari, Porsche, Lamborghini and more...

Program: **1st week-** Sailing School – drift sailing boat;
2nd week - Sport Activities and Cultural Visits;
Always assisted by Rotarians.
Detailed program will be given to all participants at the arrival.

Participants: Total 16 people, 8 girls and 8 boys, limited to one participant per country

Age: 16 - 17 years **Language:** English – good level

Accommodation: **1st week:** Sailing School of Lega Navale Italiana, 23824 Dervio (LC)
2nd week: Rotarian homestay, always assisted by rotarian members and sailing school assistants (all references of the Host Families, will be communicated before the beginning of the Camp).

Dear guests,

We are very glad to hear that you will take part in our SAIL AND NATURE Summer Camp.

The sponsoring Rotary Clubs have invited 16 boys and girls from different countries on a sightseeing and sailing camp in Dervio, in the region of Lombardy, the northern part of lake Como.

The aim and program of the camp is excursions to some of our cities, lakes and rivers and a sailing camp for beginners.

During the first week you will be under camp conditions and will take turns preparing food and drinks for the other campers. A local pizzeria will host you for the evening meal. Lodging in cottages, near the lake, will be provided by the Lega Navale Italiana (a National Institution), which will also be in charge of the sailing lessons and training.

During the second week you will be hosted by Rotarian families. Every morning the whole group will meet for the activity. Dinners will be organized by Rotarians.

English will be the official language of the camp.

Knowledge of specific sailing terms is not required.

As a participant, you could bring a reasonable amount of pocket money.

You should also have suitable insurance against illness, accidents and third party damages.

During the Camp is **absolutely forbidden drinking alcoholics and/or keep them, smoke and using drugs.**

The Camp Coordinator can, in every moment, check rooms and baggage of the participants at the Sailing Centre in Dervio, in order to verify the presence of alcoholics, and to submit participants to breath test (with disposable breath test)

The Camp Coordinator is authorized to immediately organize the return of the participant to the country of origin (the expenses will be charged to the participant's family), in case of violation of this prohibition.

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INSTRUCTIONS TO PARTICIPANTS OF THE SAILING SCHOOL

A medical certificate of physical fitness is compulsory as well as a personal declaration of swimming ability, to be sent to the camp coordinator before your arrival.

Lodging is at the camp, each participant must bring a **SLEEPING BAG**, plus **towels** and a **bathrobe**.

Each camper will partake of the rigging and unrigging of the boats, as well as their launching and hauling out.

Each day, three participants will take turns being on duty: that is, take part in cleaning, organizational and safety assignments.

Suitable clothing, should include the following items:

- bathing suits
- track suit
- woolen socks
- comfortable trousers, pullovers and sweatshirts
- **oilskin and sunglasses**
- wind breaker, k-way
- a hat and a pair of sailing gloves (windsurfing or biking ones will do)
- boat sandals or sailing shoes are required
- **anti-mosquitos spray**



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AUTHORIZATION

The Camp Program foresees a 1 hour trial of the MONZA International Racing Track. Rotarian gentlemen drivers will take the Camp Participants on board of their sport cars (Ferrari, Maserati, Lamborghini, Porsche, Corvette, etc.), under following conditions:

- Passengers will be embarked one at a time, starting from and returning to the pit-lane
- None of the participants will be allowed to drive him/herself
- The track will be rented for the event
- Under no circumstances there will be any competitive behaviour
- The tour shall not present any risk larger than driving in everyday traffic, e.g. on a highway.

Camp Participants will also have the opportunity to visit the paddock, the press room and the winners podium.

The Camp Program foresees also a visit at the JUNGLE PARK at Civenna (there will be hiking and various activity at this adventure camp, under the supervision of Rotarian people and the instructors ad the park) and a race on go-kart (**the karts are equipped with the highest technological standards and safety and speed limiter under the remote control of specialized staff**).

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SCHOOL RULES FOR THE GUESTS OF THE LEGA NAVALE IN DERVIO

Dear guests,

we would like to ask you to read and accept the following rules, in order to respect the educational aim of the Lega Navale and Rotary in Dervio

- It is necessary to show a correct behaviour and to be respectful to people and things.
- Smoking is not allowed.
- **Drinking alcoholics and using drugs is absolutely forbidden.**
- The person responsible for the group or every person of the group, in case the culprit won't be identified, will be charged for any damage to the dormitory, to the gym or to other structures of the school.
- It is compulsory to stay in your room from 22:30 to 7:00, keeping quiet.
- Canteen service:
 - o Breakfast 08:30 – 09:15
 - o Lunch 12:00 – 13:00
 - o Dinner 19:30
- The dormitory will be closed from 09.00 to 16:30
- **It's not allowed to leave the school center without prior permission of the coordinator or the Director General of the School.**

The General Director gives to the educator staff the responsibility of managing these regulations. The hospitality can be officially interrupted at any time in case the school rules aren't respected and in such case **the Camp Coordinator is authorized to immediately organize the return of the participant to the country of origin, the expenses will be charged to the participant's family.**
