Rotary Robotic Summer Camp 2016

Engagement of young participants by interactive workshops and play using primarily LEGO robot building system with programming interface to Robotics and link with Country strong position in automotive industry with site visit to plants.



Enrichment of teamwork by visiting nature beauties in Slovakia, city and culture sightseeing and sport activities.



DATES: 18th August – 29th August 2016

PARTICIPANTS: 12 participants (boys and girls), limit for 2 participants from the same country

AGE: 15 – 17 year

LOCATION: Košice, Slovakia

ACCOMMODATION: 6 days in Rotary families and 6 days in mountain cottage for teamwork with Robotics and outdoor sport & fun, in total 12 days/11 nights

LANGUAGES AND OTHER SKILLS:

Good knowledge of English (minimum B1 level is preferred)

User knowledge of work with PC and basics of programming is preferred but not a must

ARRIVAL: At Kosice Intl. Airport (KSC), on Thursday, 18th August 2016

DEPARTURE: At Kosice Intl. Airport (KSC), on Monday, 29th August 2016

OFFICIAL PAPERS: Tourist visa to Slovak Republic (only where necessary; Slovakia is EU member)

COSTS: No additional payment is required for attending the summer camp but return ticket to/from Košice Intl. Airport, Slovakia (IATA code: KSC, webpage: www.airportkosice.sk/en/) and additional pocket money are covered by camp participant. Transfer of Deposit for pocket money may be requested in advance after acceptance of the application.

Meeting with the participant in the airport and further transport, lodging, full board and programme is organized and covered by Rotary Club Kosice (incl. final departure boarding at Košice Airport).

INSURANCE: Participants should be insured against illness, accident, third party liability and repatriation according to Rotary International Requirements

PROGRAMME OF THE CAMP

The program of the first part of the camp is focused on exploring the city Košice and some nearby places. It is also planned to meet key managers and visit particular automotive industry production plants, including an automobile production and assembly plant. Participants are accommodated in Rotary families. During this time, they attend workshops about robotics, electrotechnics and physics lead by young members of worldwide successful robotic team Talentum from Košice.



In the second part of the camp, participants stay in mountain cottage to continue workshops with provided LEGO building system robots to allow fellows to try basic programming and test their own skills which gained in the educational part. Together with organizers, they build various robots and familiarize with the robotic principles.

The mind-demanding program is supported with different entertaining, relaxing sport activities, and free time in the nature. Trips to mountains Vysoké Tatry, cave and castle Spišský hrad are planned as well.



During the camp, all participants are divided into groups which play and compete in many activities through all days by collecting points.



Programme of the Camp may vary due to weather and plant or entertainment availability conditions.
