1. By train (Öresundståg) from Kastrup International Airport in Copenhagen.
2. Closest domestic airport is Ronneby Airport in Kallinge. All flights to Ronneby go via Stockholm and Arlanda International Airport (SAS flights) or from Bromma Domestic Airport (BRA flyg) in Stockholm.
3. Stena Line ferries operates the line Gdynia (Poland) - Karlskrona.
4. DFDS Seaways ferries operates the line Klaipeda (Lithuania) – Karlshamn.
