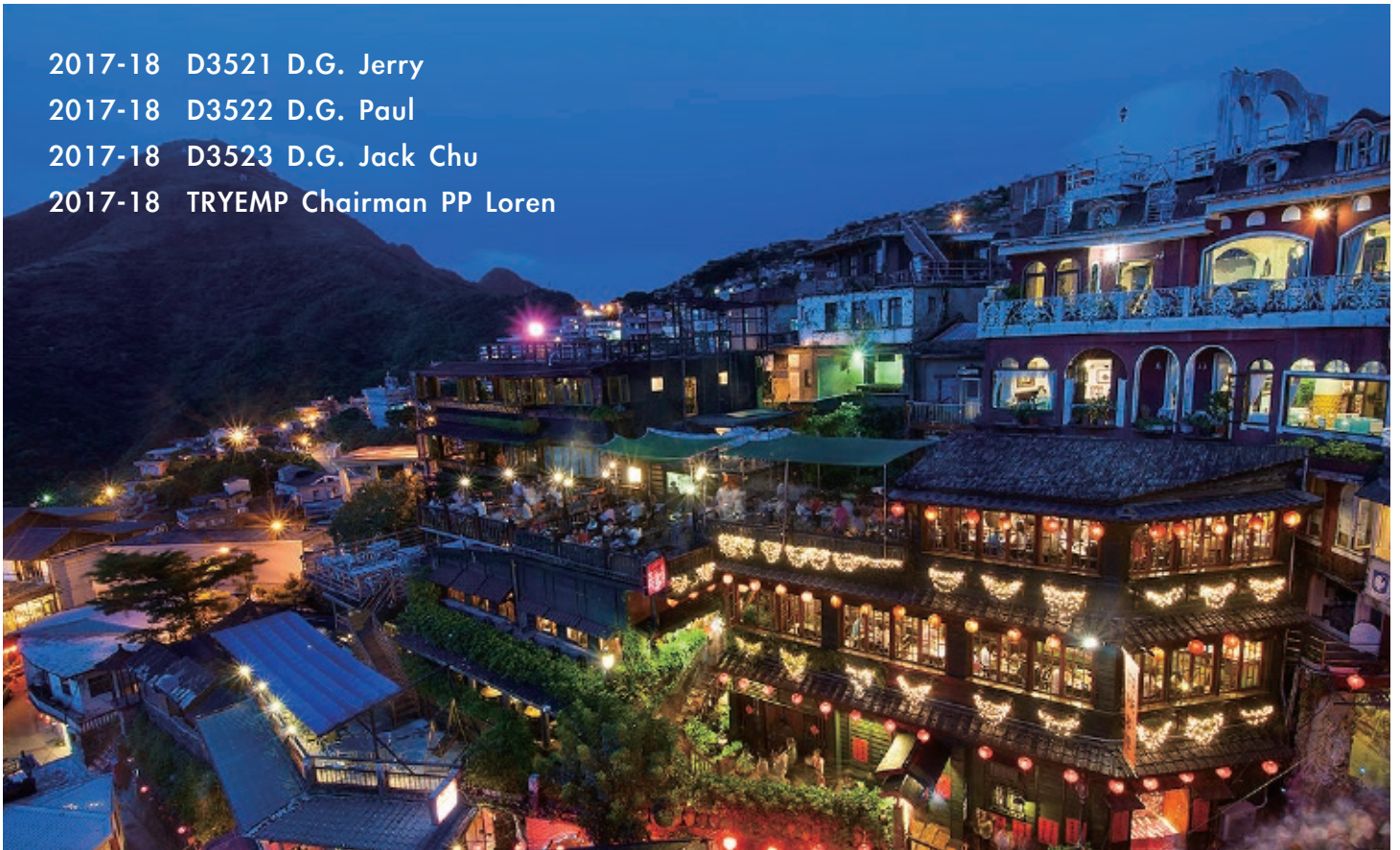

AGE

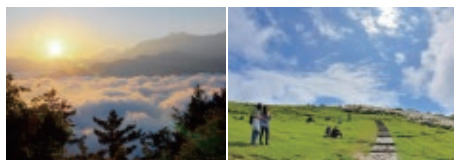
18 – 25 years old
